AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT SEWER RATES FOR THE TOWN OF CLIFTON FORGE AND TOWN OF IRON GATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023

WHEREAS, pursuant to Va. Code § 15.2-2122, the Board of Supervisors is required to adopt rates for users of its wastewater system that are fair and reasonable, and reasonably reflect the costs of operating the system; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Iron Gate, the Town of Clifton Forge, and Alleghany County have agreed on a method of calculating sewer rates for the Towns, which is reflected by the rate adopted herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Alleghany County Board of Supervisors that the following sewer rates be adopted for the Town of Clifton Forge and the Town of Iron Gate for fiscal year 2023:

APPROVE TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2022:

On motion of Mr. Nicely, seconded by Mr. Bennett, that the following resolution be adopted:

LEVY FOR TAX YEAR 2022

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Alleghany County Board of Supervisors that there be and is hereby levied for the tax year 2022 a tax of seventy-three cents (\$0.73) per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation on all taxable real estate, and all taxable mobile homes as defined in Section 46.2-100, Code of Virginia, located in this County, and that there be, and is hereby levied for the tax year 2022, a tax of two dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$2.98) per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation on all taxable and tangible personal property (including machinery and tools segregated by Section 58.1-3507, Code of Virginia), located in this County on January 1, 2022 and the respective levies hereby ordered being also applicable to the real estate and tangible personal property of public service corporations, based upon the assessment thereof fixed by the State Corporation Commission and duly certified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that by majority vote in accordance with Section 58.1-3503(A)(3) and Section 58.1-3503(B) of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the 2022 personal property tax assessment (as defined by State Code 58.1-3503(A)(3)) will utilize a 75% ratio against the assessed value according to the National Automobile Dealers Association (NADA) pricing guide to allow for temporary tax relief (as defined by State Code 58.1-3503(B)) due to the appreciation of vehicles as a result of the economic impact of COVID-19.
