



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Removal and Disposal of Waste Tires

County of Alleghany, Virginia

The County of Alleghany, Virginia, is seeking proposals for the removal and disposal of waste tires received at the Island Ford Transfer Station. The chosen contractor shall pick-up and dispose of automobile tires, truck tires, and mobile equipment tires, including tires mounted on rims. Proposals shall include a list of all sizes and types of tires that will and will not be accepted in the disposal program. Contractor shall also document compliance with all applicable environmental laws, regulations and/or permits. Contractors shall furnish a certified letter or other appropriate documentation verifying its' program of the proper and lawful disposal of waste tires. The waste tires will become the property of the contractor upon departure from the County's property. Contractor shall provide Alleghany County with a waste tire certificate for each load removed.

The submitted proposal must address the basic services in the Request for Proposal to be considered responsive. Other services may be proposed, but only after the basic services are addressed.

The envelope must be clearly marked on the outside with your company's name and labeled "Removal and Disposal of Waste Tires".
