- 2. This permit must be kept on the work site and shown when requested.
- 3. Applicant agrees to be responsible for any and all damages to any other installations already in place as a result of work covered by this permit.
- 4. Applicant agrees to maintain the work in the manner approved upon its completion.
- 5. A permit may be denied any applicant and all permits issued by the County may be revoked whenever in the opinion of the Board of Supervisors or their designated agent (Local Erosion and Sedimentation Program Administrator), the safety, use or maintenance of the property so requires.
- 6. Applicant agrees to obtain all necessary permits and adhere to all regulations per the Alleghany County Code and all other applicable state and federal agencies.

Section 30-40 of the Alleghany County Code requires that a Bond or Surety be posted with the County in the amount determined by the Local Program Administrator. Such Bond shall be conditioned to conform any work to approved standards, specifications, and criteria as set out in the Approved Erosion & Sediment Control Plan.

Final inspection of the project shall be made by the Local Program Administrator in conjunction with the Plan approving authority if requested by the former. The release of bonds and sureties is contingent upon the findings. Release shall occur within thirty (30) days after disturbed areas are deemed permanently stabilized by the Program Administrator.
